## Overview

Boudewijn Waaijer is of counsel of Dentons Boekel (formerly Boekel). He has worked in several civil law notary firms since 1983. As from 1998 till 2016 he was employed as civil law notary.

He specializes in company law and estate planning, in particular family business related issues. His estate planning advice focuses on wealthy private individuals, wills and charitable donations. Boudewijn is part of the Healthcare industry group at Dentons Boekel.

For nine years he worked at the University of Nijmegen as lecturer in notarial law. From 2008 until September 2018 Boudewijn was endowed professor of notarial law (in particular notarial practice) at the University of Amsterdam. In 2015 he was appointed professor of notarial law at the Free University of Amsterdam. He is a member of the editorial staff of the Weekly Journal for Private Law, the Notarial Profession and Registration.

Boudewijn is the author of several publications in the field of company law, inheritance law and notarial law. At the University of Nijmegen he received a doctorate in 1993 on the thesis Articles of Associations and Amendments. He is author of the manual about the profession of the civil law notary in the Netherlands (last edition 2019), co-author of a manual about Inheritance law (last edition 2015) and wrote a book about the shareholders' agreement (edition 1996).

He advises both family business companies and non-profit organizations in respect of company law and the law of legal entities. His experience includes governance issues, reorganizations and restructuring, for instance mergers and divisions of legal entities.
